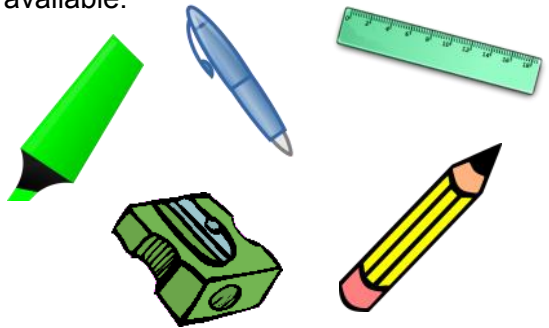
The next scene setting meeting is for Year 8 parents on Thursday, 28th September, starting at 7.30pm.
