


## **Manchester Champions!**

## Mother Tongue Other Tongue



From Head of Modern Foreign Languages, Mrs Jones:

“Earlier this term, the LRB, MFL and English department organised for Trinity students to take part in ‘Mother Tongue Other Tongue’ - a writing competition which celebrate languages. Students had the opportunity to either transcribe a piece in their Mother Tongue and explain, in English, why it was meaningful to them, or they could write a poem in Spanish or French, which are the languages they are learning in school.

The Poet Laureate, Dame Carol Ann Duffy, has announced that the 'Mother Tongue Other Tongue' competition continues to be her Laureate Education Project. This idea was originally developed by the Faculty of Arts and Humanities at Manchester Metropolitan University and Routes into Languages North West. This national multilingual poetry competition has already inspired over 24,000 students and aims to celebrate cultural diversity and the many languages currently spoken in schools across the UK. The winners for the Regional (North West) and National competition will be announced at a very special celebration event, attended by a VIP, which will be held on Monday, 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2018, at Manchester Metropolitan University.
