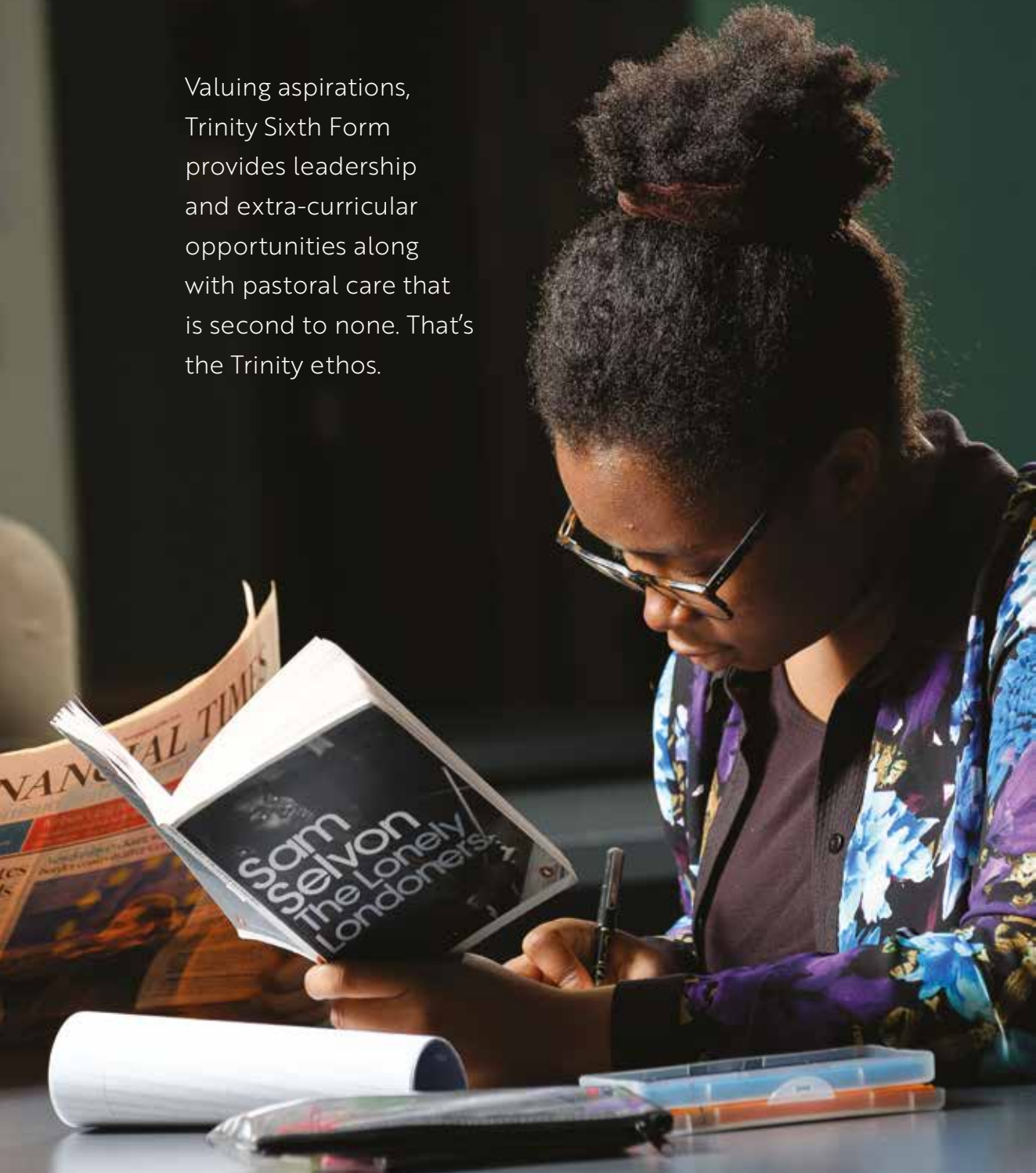

Our Aspiring Medics scheme is a fully funded scholarship opportunity for prospective medical students to receive help, training, guidance and fiscal support in their applications for medical school. We also run a Gateway programme for the most academic students to achieve places at the best universities in the UK and further afield. For those seeking alternatives to university, we provide opportunities to explore apprenticeships and employability through our careers service.

Trinity Sixth Formers are encouraged to make the most of their summer holidays between Year 12 and Year 13 by applying for university summer schools and enrichment activities. Taking advantage of these opportunities puts them head and shoulders above their peers when it comes to applying for university. Our students have participated in the Manchester Access Programme (MAP), Sutton Trust, Oxford and Cambridge summer schools, UNIQ, Nuffield Research placements, amongst others. Trinity Sixth Form is a vibrant and exciting place to be; not only is our academic provision outstanding but our enrichment opportunities mean our students can become the very best versions of themselves: responsible and independent learners with a proactive grasp of their futures.

In the academic year 2017/18, we were deemed to be "Outstanding" by Ofsted. Our state of the art facilities in our £3 million Sixth Form Centre, and excellent teaching and learning, means that Trinity Sixth Form is an ideal location for you to further your education and prepare for your future.

Every Sixth Form student is an individual and we respect the fact that all students are different. The support and guidance you receive at Trinity is bespoke, focused on the individual and tailor-made to help you succeed. Support comes from many different places: Head of Sixth Form; Form Tutors; pastoral support from our Student Services; scholastic support from our Academic Tutor, as well as peer support from our diverse and determined students.

There is a focus on leadership opportunities with students able to apply to be Head Boy, Head Girl or a member of the Prefect team, supporting the staff and students throughout the school. Our staff go above and beyond to support our students and we expect the same level of dedication and commitment from every learner. We celebrate success and encourage all students to take an active role in their own development. Expectations are high; Trinity Sixth Formers produce work of an exceptional standard and understand fully that only their best is good enough. This understanding will carry them through the next stages of their life-long learning journey wherever it may take them.

Ideally positioned within the heart of the University Quarter of Manchester, Trinity Sixth Form has excellent partnerships with University of Manchester and Manchester Metropolitan University, giving all students unique access and opportunities that other institutions may struggle to provide. Being a school Sixth Form allows us to provide these advantages to everyone rather than a selected few.

Trinity Sixth Form work closely with Elevate Education, who deliver sessions throughout the year to develop our students' independent learning as well as giving them expert advice on revision and study skills to help them achieve top-grades in the summer examinations. We value high-quality provision that will expand our students' prospects. We also work side by side with Unifrog to help Sixth Formers widen their awareness of university courses and the apprenticeship opportunities available to them.

# A wider knowledge.

Universities and employers are now expecting students to have a wider knowledge base than lessons can provide. As a consequence all Sixth Formers are encouraged to expand their horizons by reading academic books and journals extensively, and by doing this, developing their understanding of key concepts and debates within their subject areas.







# A world of opportunities.

Enrichment opportunities include work experience or volunteering in Year 12, Duke of Edinburgh's Gold Award, sports activities, public speaking, Gold Arts Award in Music and Drama, Languages including BSL, first aid, self-defence and supporting pupils in the school as prefects. In addition, visiting speakers from charities, business and the arts provide an inspirational insight into different walks of life.

As well as joining the various sport teams, Sixth Formers can use the school's fitness suite and any of the facilities in Trinity Sport Centre as a privilege of being a Sixth Former. There are many opportunities for students to showcase their dramatic, musical and artistic talents and

Sixth Formers plan and run a whole host of charity events and participate in community service initiatives which are often highlighted in our school newsletter.

The Sixth Form Journal, Metis, recently published, is full of interesting and stimulating academic articles and gives creative Sixth Formers an outlet for their writing. Students can be part of the journal editorial team in Year 12.

We believe that to truly succeed young people have to develop an array of skills not just those learnt in the classroom, that's why we dedicate time every week to enrichment studies.

# Realise your goals.

Trinity Sixth Form is committed to providing young people with practical and personalised advice to help them shape their futures. We understand the importance in self-motivation, initiative and leadership as they prepare for life after Trinity. We actively encourage students to take on responsibility, with our prefects and leadership roles or out of school through volunteering and work experience.

Our Aspirations week, held annually, explores post-18 options for learners. All students are given the opportunity to access tools and experts to help realise their potential: Unifrog, GM Higher, University visits, careers interviews, universities' admissions tutors and personal statement workshops provided by the University of Manchester. During this week we launch our UCAS programme which guides our students, step by step, through the applications process with detailed information as well as impartial advice to ensure all learners set and achieve appropriate goals. Students are all encouraged to attend university open days, discovery days and we take the whole Year 12



cohort to the UCAS Convention in Manchester each year. Our careers service provides 1:1 support for all students throughout the year, whether it is linked to UCAS applications or creating a CV for employment. In addition to this we have visitors from various industry sectors who speak to our students about employment prospects and the career paths they can take.
