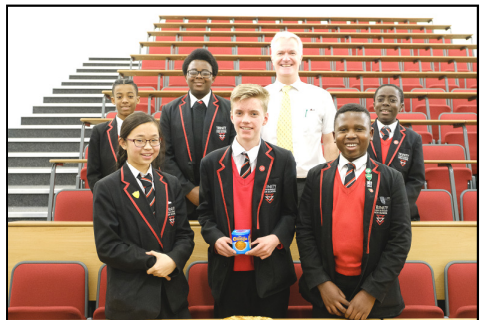
Dazzling Drumming!

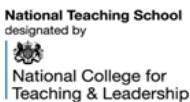
