The Year 10 parents' evening took place in a new venue, the Sixth Form Centre, last week, with an abundance of positive conversations taking place.

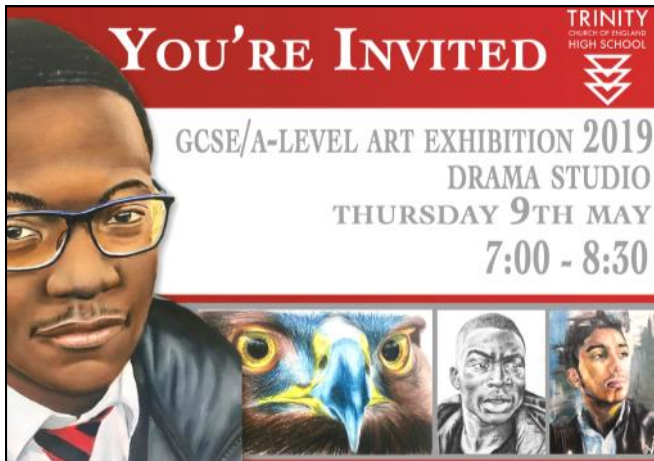


Ex-Trinity Student

Art Exhibition

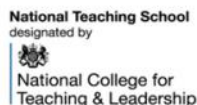
There is less than one week to go before our art exhibition. It's going to be a great celebration of art at Trinity - you won't want to miss it!
