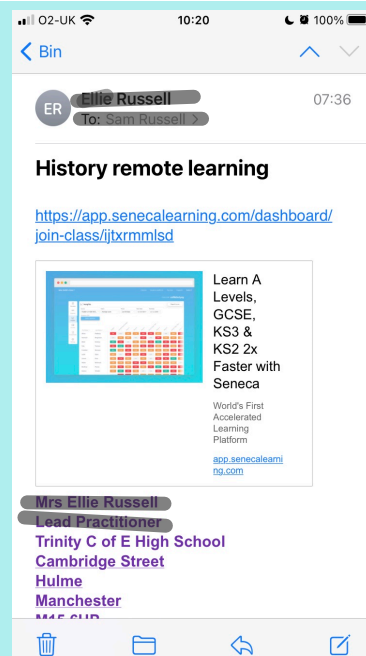
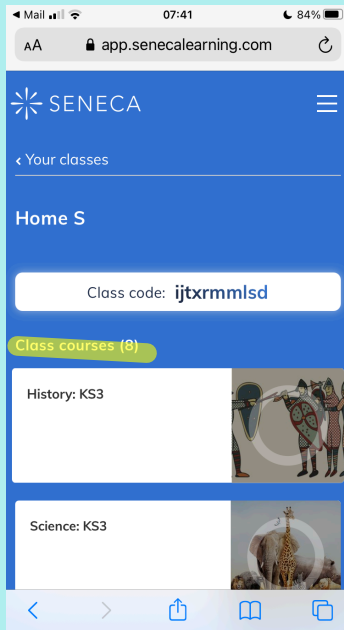


How to access assignments on Seneca Learning

or via your MS Teams class channel.

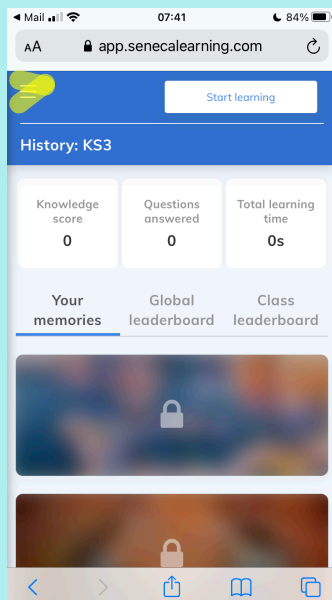




This student has signed in to the class and can see that 8 courses have been added.

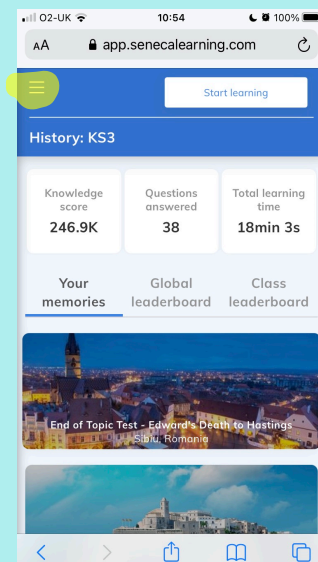
To find the **history task** so the student needs to click on the History KS3 icon...

Access History:KS3 course - click on the three line icon

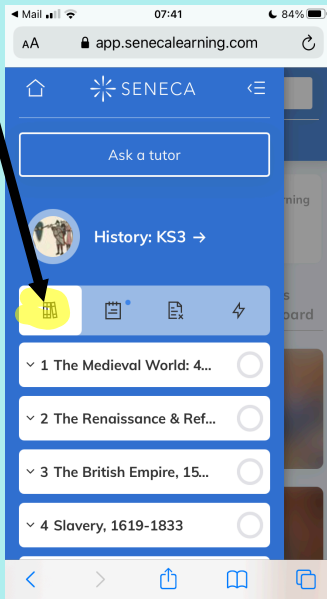


The first time you access the course, Your knowledge score is zero.

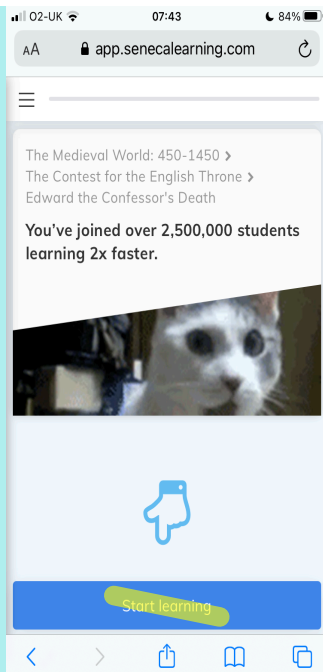
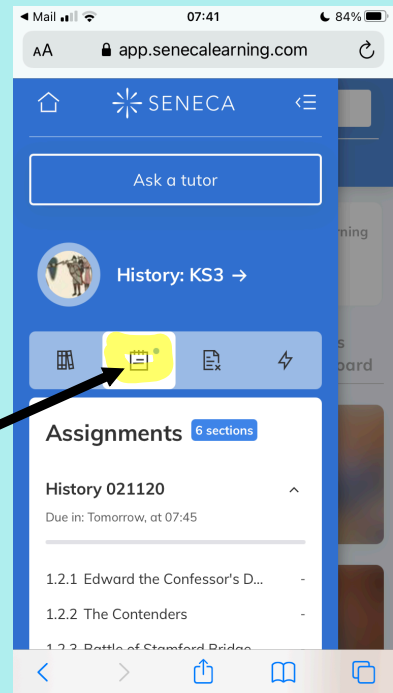
In future you'll see an update on the number of questions you've answered, time spent using the app etc.



Students can learn and revise independently, at ANY time, by accessing the course here (The library books icon)



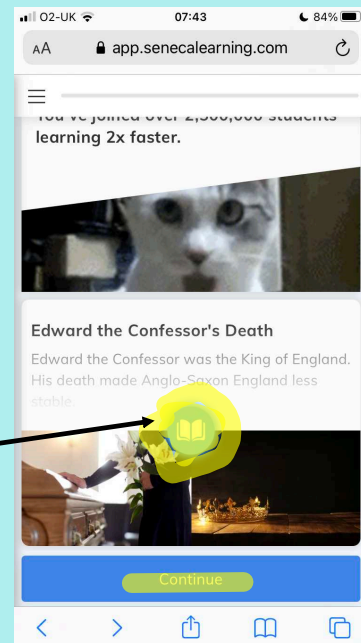
To find the specific **assignment** that has been set, click on the notepad icon. The blue circle indicates that it has recently been updated. A new assignment has been added.



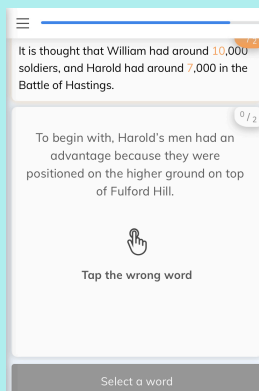
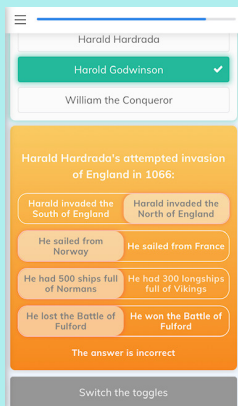
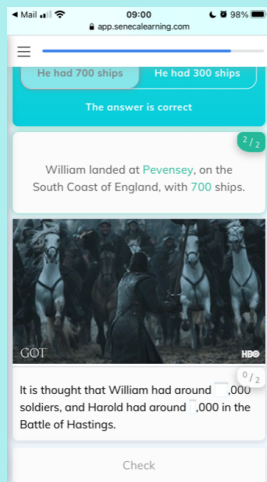
Start, by clicking on '**Start learning**'

The website will then provide some information on the study topic.

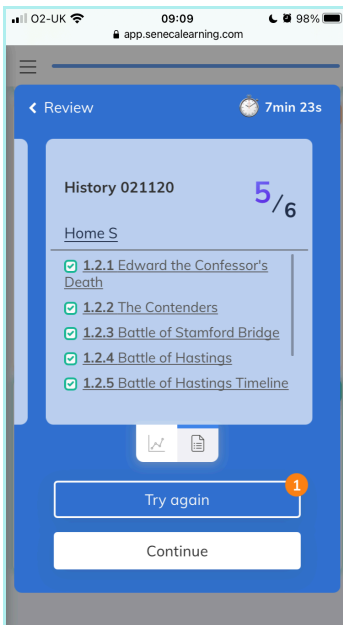
Click on this **book** icon to read more information, before clicking on '**Continue**'



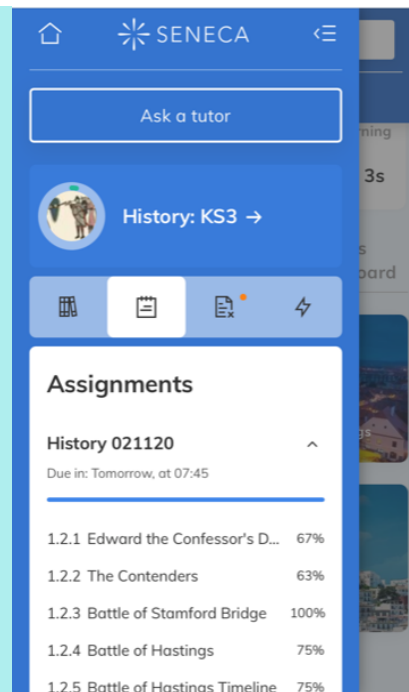
There are different styles of questions. E.g. some are gap fills, some are 'toggle switches', some are 'spot the mistake'.



At ANY stage, the reader can go back to previous information and read it again before answering.



You can view your progress and try again to get a better score when you have time.
