## **Year 11 Prom**

This event is now taking place on Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> July, from 7pm – 11pm at Hotel Football in the 'Old Trafford Supporters Club' Main Suite. Parking near the venue can be difficult so please consider this if dropping off and collecting your child. We are really looking forward to celebrating with them after the challenges of key stage 4.

## **Year 11 Final Assembly**

Following the prom, Year 11 will have their traditional final assembly during period five on Tuesday, 20<sup>th</sup> July. Students will enter school via the fish pond entrance from 2.05pm. Students are able to wear their own clothing to this final assembly. It is always a wonderful event where we reflect on the journey made by your child over the last five years and then look towards the next exciting stage of their lives.

## **Final 'Teacher Assessed Grades' (TAG) Update**

## **GCSE Results Day and Follow Up Support**

At present students can still contact Rosie Gill (our careers adviser) at any time if they require support regarding Year 12 options or careers advice. She is contactable via email at [Rosie.Gill@careerconnect.org.uk](mailto:Rosie.Gill@careerconnect.org.uk) Rosie Gill will also be present to support students on GCSE results day which this year is on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> August. Students will be able to collect their results from 10am and will be able to enter school via the fish pond area. Unfortunately, parents will not be able to enter the building with their children on this day. If your child is not available on this day to collect their results our exams officer will email them to their individual school email account. Results will also be posted home on Friday, 13<sup>th</sup> August, if not collected in person.



### **Trinity 6<sup>th</sup> Form Enrolment**

After receiving their results, students will be able to enrol for Trinity 6<sup>th</sup> Form if they have an offer and meet the entrance criteria. Each student will receive an individual letter in their results pack explaining when and how to enrol. Some students will enrol on 12<sup>th</sup> August, some will be invited in on 13<sup>th</sup> August to enrol and discuss their options. Our dedicated team will be on hand to support enrolment and to offer further advice and guidance if needed.
