It was a superb performance from our girls winning 50 - 8. The MVP (most valuable player) awards went to two Trinity sisters, Irene and Janel!”



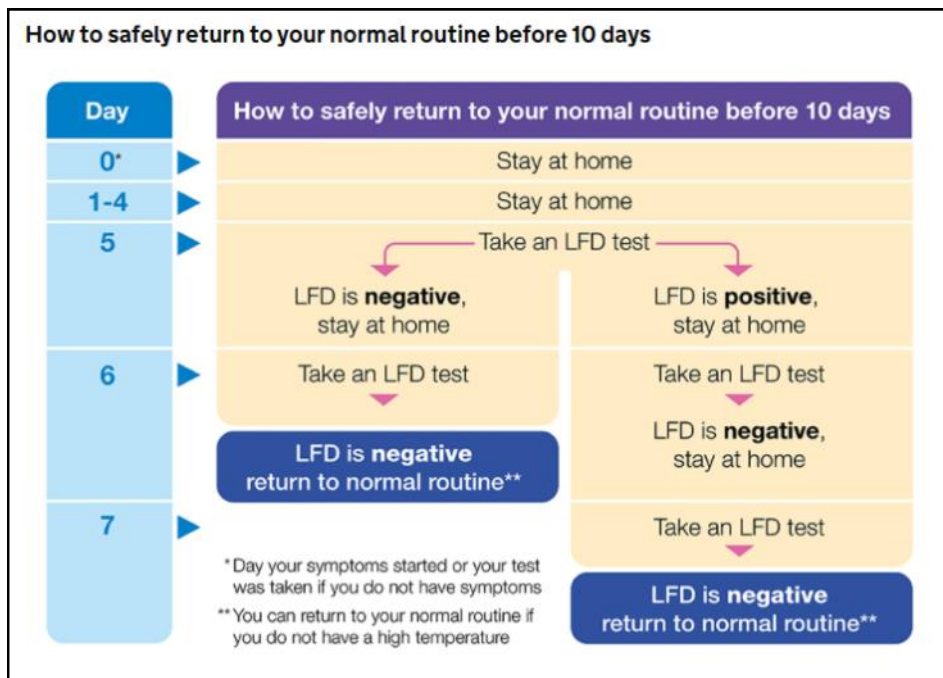
