

Trinity Sixth Form Dress Code

Trinity Sixth Form students are expected to dress in a manner appropriate to a purposeful, safe, secure and diverse sixth form. Students should be mindful that at all times they are representing the school and our Sixth Form. Whilst we recognise that self-expression is part of being an emerging adult, items of dress that may reasonably be expected to cause offence to any member of the Sixth Form or wider community, such as T-shirts bearing inappropriate language or images, or particularly revealing items of clothing, are not allowed to be worn. The following guidelines are set out to avoid offence or a breach of health and safety rules.

- No caps or hats, bandanas or hoods are to be worn on site.
- No ripped jeans or similar.
- No sportswear (eg. Track suits, jogging bottoms) unless you are in a PE lesson.
- No clothing with offensive wording, logos, images or association.
- No clothes which expose an excessive amount of flesh and /or underwear including short denim or jeans shorts.
- Leggings or jeggings may be worn but need to be accompanied with a top, jumper or dress that completely covers the bottom.

Student ID badges on lanyards must be worn at all times.
